AIM Toolbar

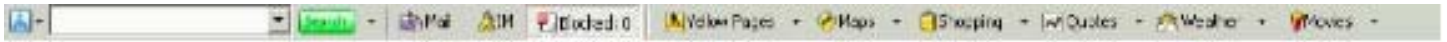


You may have an AIM Toolbar if you have AOL Instant Messenger.

To disable pop-up blockers on AIM Toolbar:

1. Click the AIM button on the left side of the Toolbar. This opens up a drop-down list.
2. Click on the **Toolbar Options** in the drop-down list to open the **AIM Toolbar Options**
3. Choose the **Popup Blocker** Tab and uncheck the **Block Popup Windows** box.
4. Click the **OK** button.

AOL Toolbar



This is the pop-up blocker icon:



If you click on the icon, it will change to the following:



This is now allowing pop-ups from websites.

If you would like to turn on the pop-up blocker after you are done with the Spotlight Awards application, click on the button again and the Blocked Icon will re-appear allowing you to know that pop-ups are now blocked again.

Earthlink



To disable pop-up blockers in Earthlink:

1. Click the **Protection** button on your Earthlink toolbar.
 2. Click on **Pop-Up Blocker** and then click on **Options**.
 3. Select: **Off - Do not block any pop-ups**
 4. Click on **Apply** and then click **OK** to close the options window.

Comcast

Comcast provides Pop-up Blockers. The Privacy Settings allow you to enable or disable pop-ups.

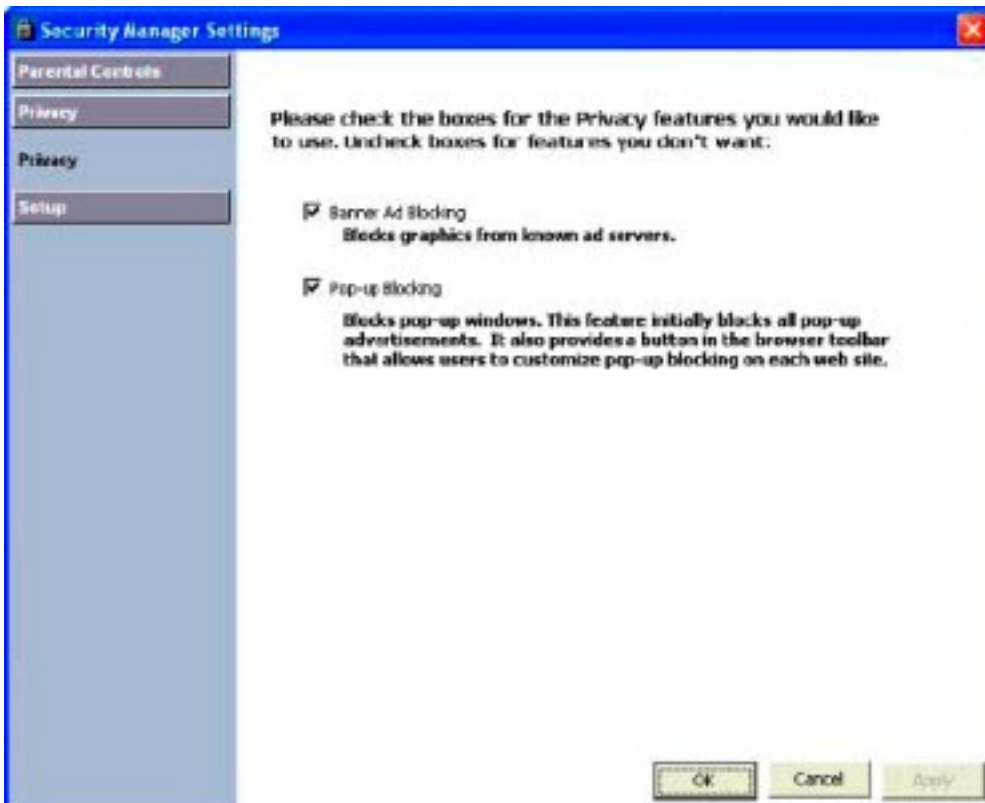
1. Select the **Privacy** button from the Security Manager.



2. You will be given a drop-down menu. Select **Privacy Settings**.



3. Make sure that the **Pop-up Blocking** box is unchecked and then click **OK**.



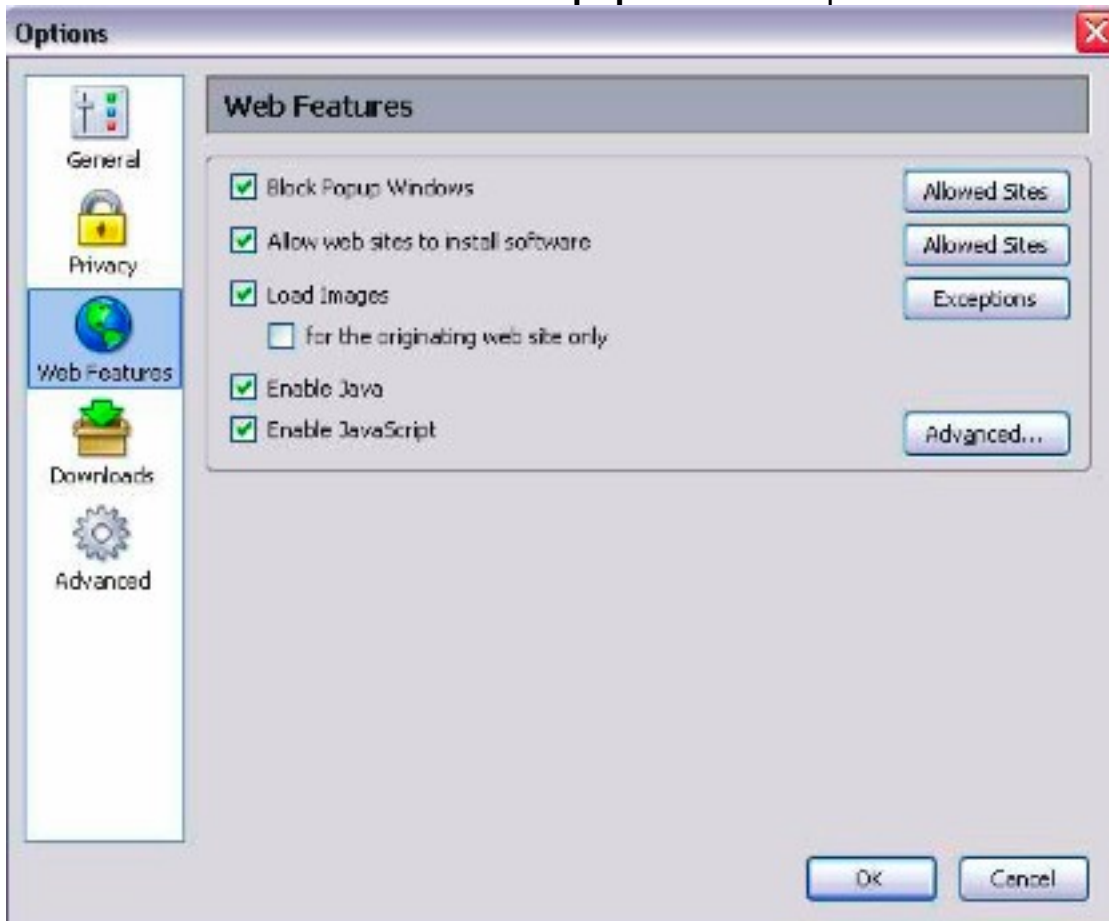
Mozilla Firefox

If you are on a PC:

1. Open your Firefox Internet Browser and then click on the **Tools** menu which is located on the top bar and click on **Options**



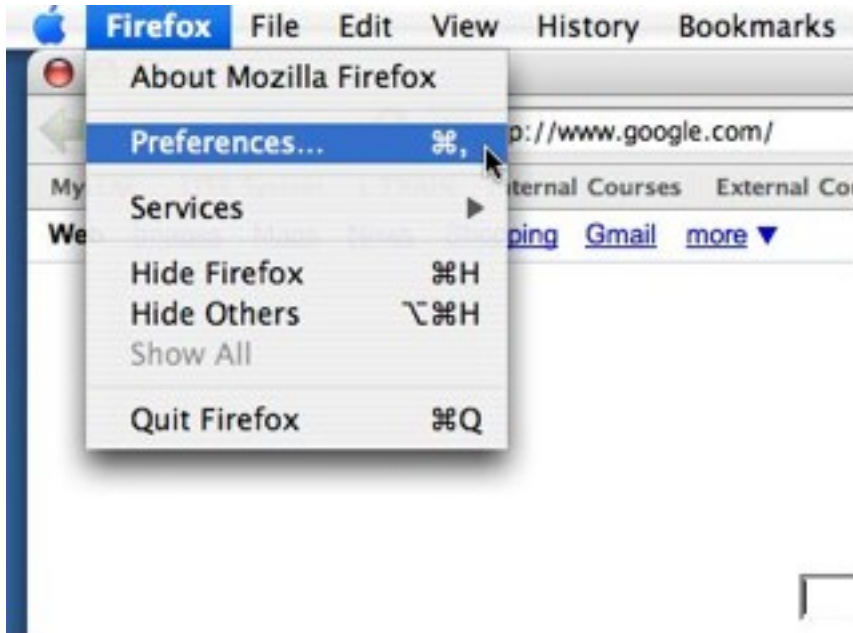
2. When this window appears, click on the **Web Features** option on the left list. Then uncheck the box for the **Block Popup Windows** option and click on **OK**.



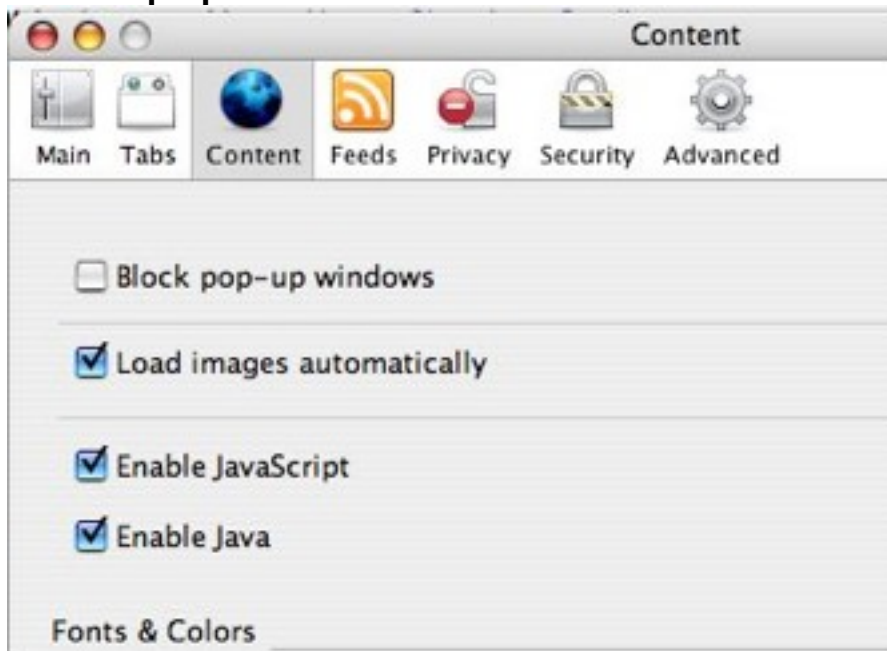
Mozilla Firefox

If you are on a Mac OSX:

1. Open your Firefox Internet Browser and then click on the **Firefox** menu at the top of your screen and then click on **Preferences**.

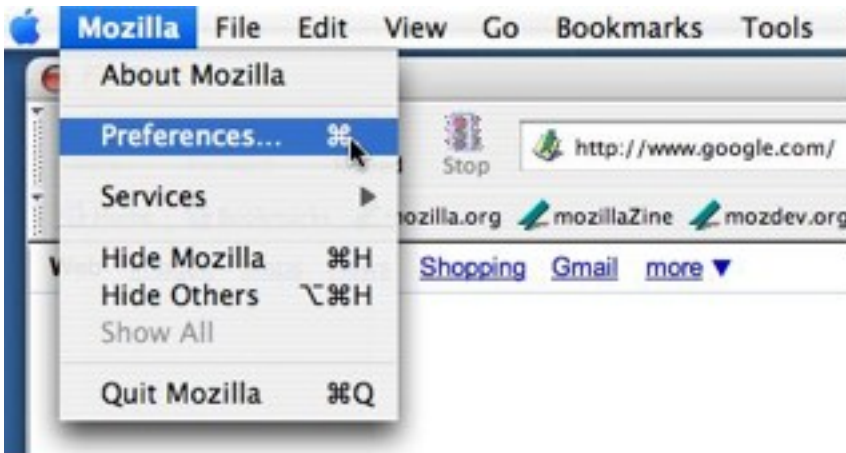


2. This should open the **Preferences** window. Choose the **Content** button and then uncheck **Block Pop-up Windows**.



Mozilla Pop-up Blocker (Mac OSX)

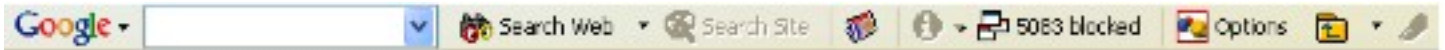
1. Click on the **Mozilla** menu at the top of your screen and then click on **Preferences**



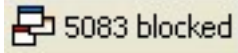
2. From the **Preferences** window, click on the **Privacy & Security** option and then choose **Popup Windows**. Uncheck **Block unrequested popup windows** and then click **OK**.



Google Toolbar



This is the pop-up Blocker icon:



If you click on the icon, it will change to the following:

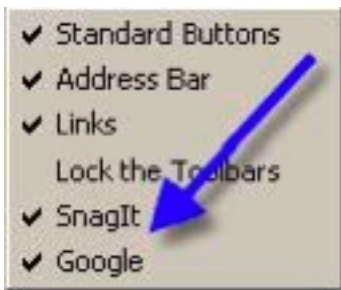


This is now allowing pop-ups from websites.

If you would like to turn on the pop-up blocker after you are done with the Spotlight Awards application, click on the button again and the Blocked Icon will re-appear allowing you to know that pop-ups are now blocked again.

If Google toolbar is the only pop-up blocker you have and after disabling, you are still having problems, you may need to disable to Google toolbar.

1. Right-click on the Google toolbar, and a drop-down menu will appear.



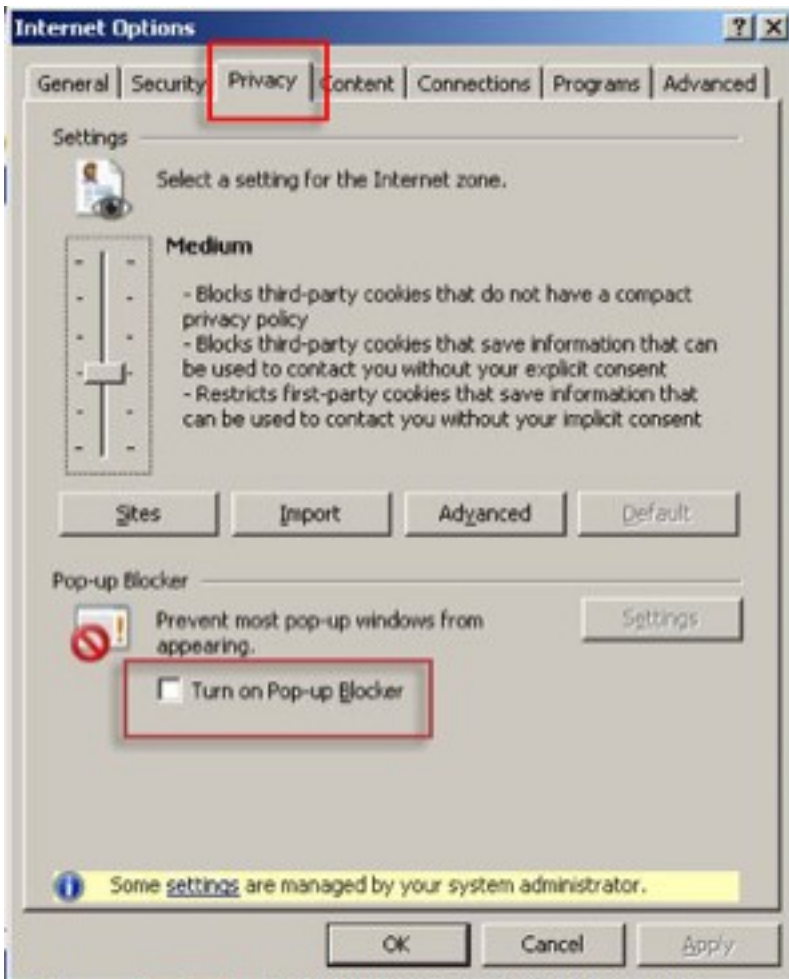
2. Uncheck **Google** to disable the Google Toolbar. To enable to Google Toolbar, right-click again in the Toolbar area and recheck **Google**.

Internet Explorer 7 (Windows XP)

1. Open your Internet Explorer Browser and then click on the **Tools** menu at the top of your screen and select **Internet Options**.



2. Click on the **Privacy** tab and then uncheck **Turn on Pop-up Blocker** and then click **OK**.



Internet Explorer 6 (Windows XP)

1. Open your Internet Explorer Browser and then click on the **Tools** menu at the top of your screen and select **Internet Options**.



2. Click on the **Privacy** tab and then uncheck **Block pop-ups** and then click **OK**.



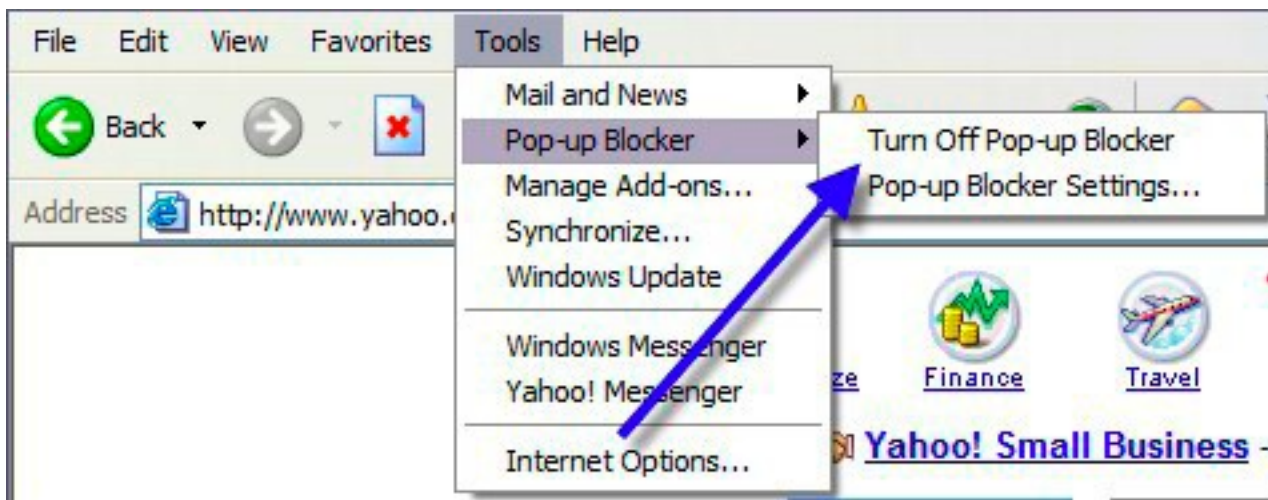
McAfee Internet Security

1. Point your cursor to **McAfee Pop-up Blocker**
 2. De-select Enable **Pop-up Blocker**

Microsoft Service Pack 2

The pop-up Blocker is now integrated into Internet Explorer with Microsoft Service Pack 2.

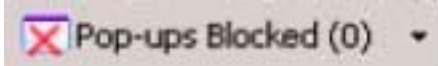
1. Open your Internet Explorer.
2. Go to your **Tools** menu at the top of your page.
3. Select **Pop-up Blocker** and then select **Turn Off Pop-up Blocker**.



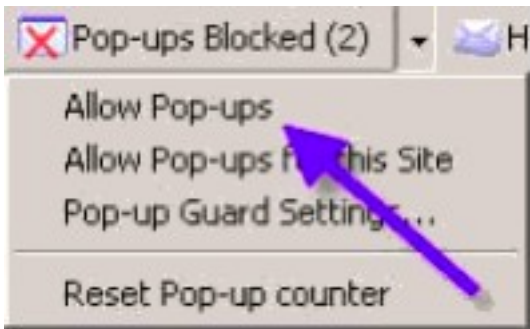
MSN Toolbar



This is the pop-up blocker icon:



Click on the down arrow next to the text to bring up a menu of options and then click on **Allow Pop-Ups**.



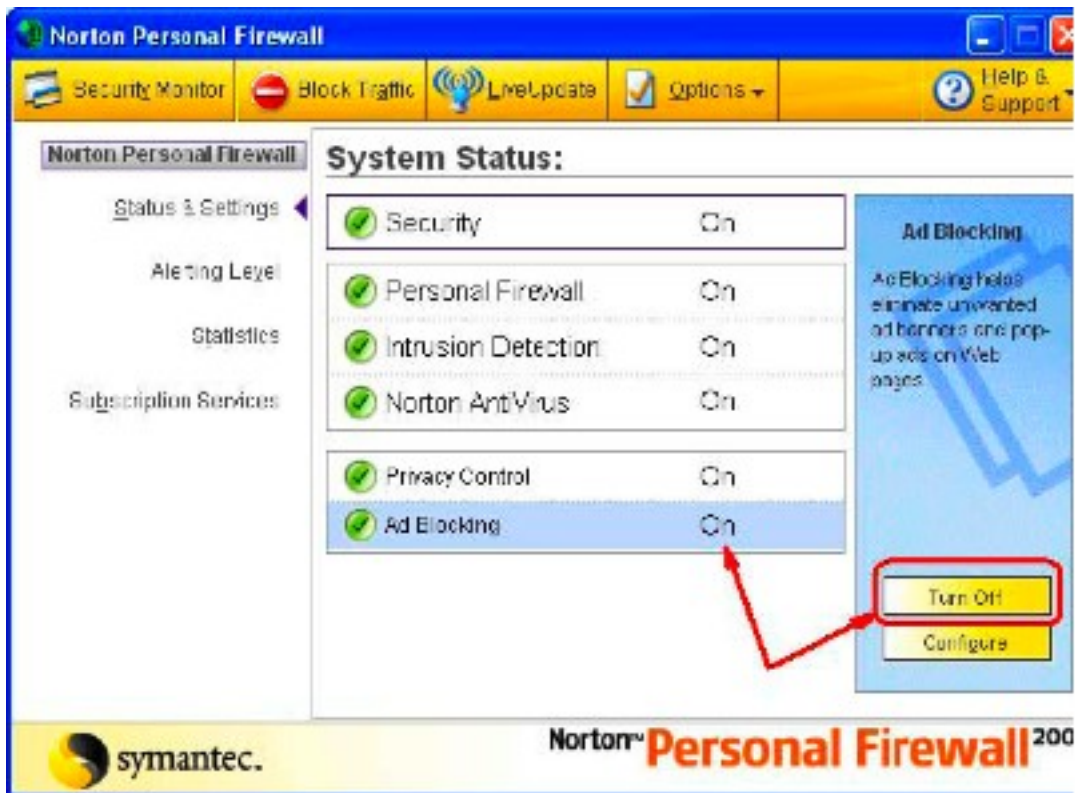
Netscape

1. Open your Netscape Internet Browser and then click on the **Edit** menu at the top of your screen and select the **Preferences** option.
2. Click on the arrow next to **Privacy & Security** on the left side of the window and then select **Pop Up Windows**. Remove the checkmark next to **Block unrequested popup windows** and then click OK.



Norton Internet Security/Firewall Pop-up Blocker

1. Go to the Windows **Start Menu**, select **All Programs** and then **Norton Firewall**.
2. Click on **Ad Blocking** located on the bottom middle of the window and then click on **Turn Off** on the bottom right of the window.



Norton AntiSpam and Norton Internet Security 2005 And 2006

1. There should be a yellow/black orb icon in your system tray in the bottom right hand corner of your computer screen. You can right click on it and then select **Disable**.
2. If you do not have this icon, go to the Windows **Start Menu**, select **All Programs** and then **Norton Internet Security**
3. In the window that appears, click on **Norton AntiSpam**.
4. Click on **Status and Settings** under **Norton AntiSpam**. If there is a green checkmark next to **Pop-up Blocking**, click on the words **Pop-up Blocking** and then **Turn Off** on the bottom right of that window so that it looks like below:



4. The final step is to clear out your Cache. Open your internet browser and then click on **Tools** at the top menu on your screen and then select **Internet Options**. Then click on the **Delete Files** button to clear your Cache.

Norton AntiSpam and Norton Internet Security 2004 and earlier

1. There should be a green and blue orb icon in your system tray in the bottom right hand corner of your computer screen. You can right click on it and then select **Disable**.
2. If you do not have this icon, go to the Windows **Start Menu**, select **All Programs** and then **Norton Internet Security**.
3. Click on **Status and Settings** under Norton Internet Security on the left hand side of the window that appears. If there is a green checkmark next to **Ad Blocking**, click on the words **Ad Blocking** and then **Turn Off** on the bottom right of the window.

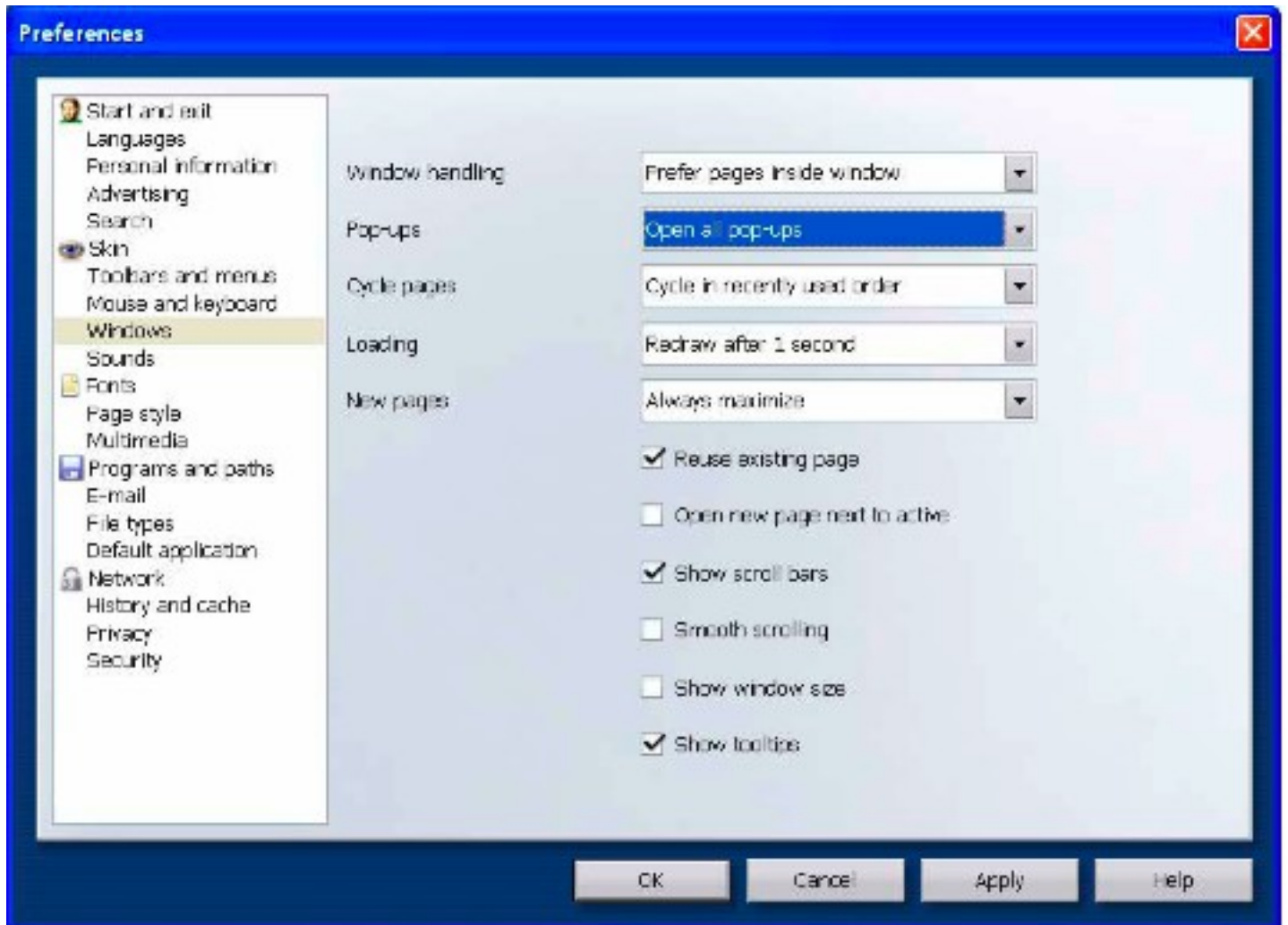


4. The final step is to clear out your Cache. Open your internet browser and then click on **Tools** at the top menu on your screen and then select **Internet Options**. Then click on the **Delete Files** button to clear your Cache.

Opera

1. Open your Opera Internet Browser. Click on the **Tools** menu and then select the **Preferences** option.

2. When the following window appears, click on the **Windows** option in the list on the left hand side. Select the **Open all pop-ups** in the **Pop-up** list and then click **OK** to close the window.



Popup Cop

If you have Popup cop, this will be in the toolbar of your browser:



To disable the pop-up blocking, click on the **arrow** to the right of the badge to bring up a menu of options and then click on **Disable PopUpCop**.

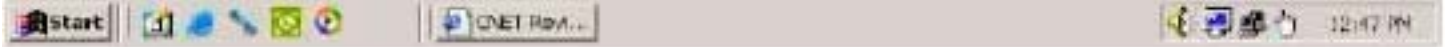


Popup Manager

1. Open up your Internet Browser and then go to <http://spotlight.musiccenter.org>
 2. Now right click on the small color-coded area (either red or green) in the bottom left corner of your browser window.
 3. In the drop-down menu, select the option to Allow Popups from <http://spotlight.musiccenter.org>.

Pop-up Stopper

1. This program will put an icon of a white hand with the index finger pointing up in the lower right corner of your Start Menu Toolbar.



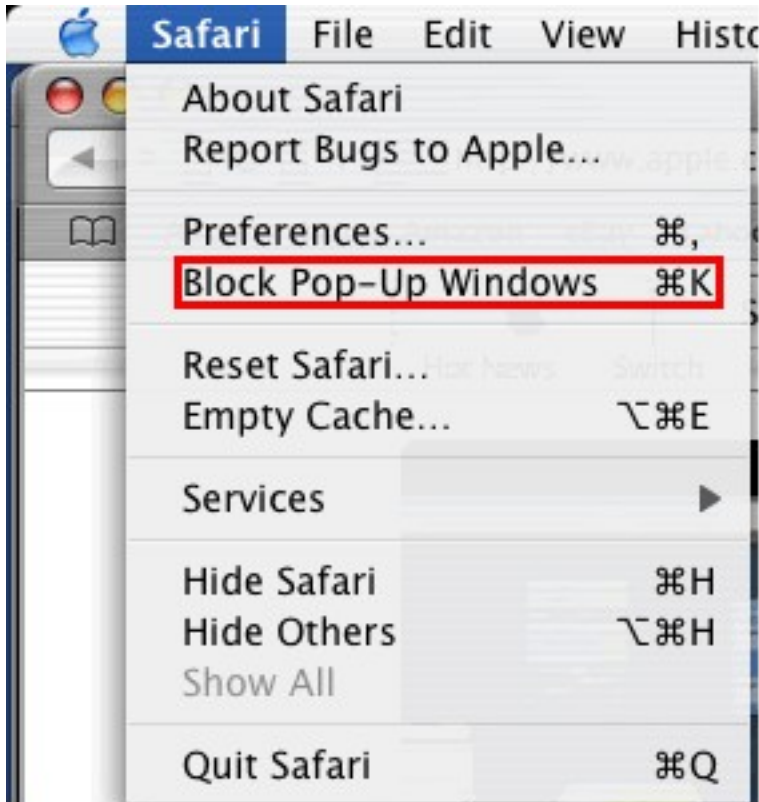
This is the icon

2. Right click on the icon to bring up a menu with a list of options and then uncheck the option **Block pop-up ad windows**.



Safari

1. Open your Safari Internet Browser and click on the **Safari** menu option at the top of your screen.
2. Remove the checkmark next to **Block pop-up windows**



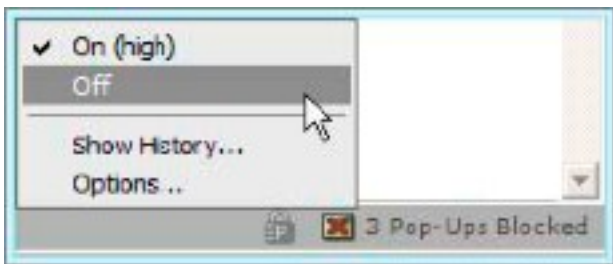
SBC Yahoo! Browser Pop-up Blocker

There are three different ways to turn off the Pop-up Blocker:

1. Go to the SBC Yahoo! Browser menu and select **Settings**, then **Pop-up Blocker**, and then **Off** to turn it off.



2. You can also look at the bottom border of the SBC Yahoo! Browser and click the **Pop-Up Blocker** Button and then select **Off**.



3. You can also toggle the **Turn On/Turn Off** button on the **Online Protection Dashboard**.

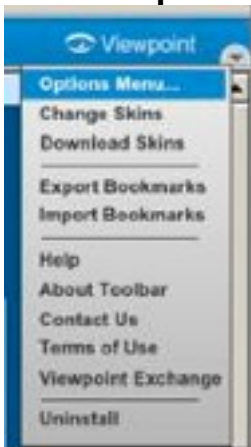


Starware Toolbar

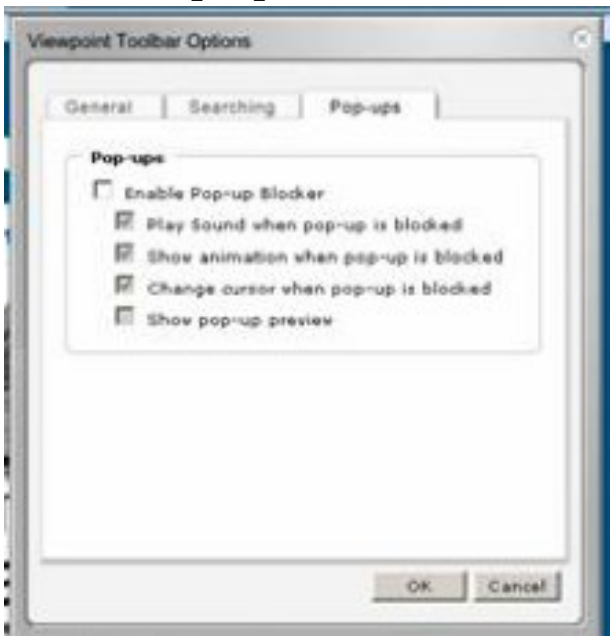
1. Click the arrow next to the **Starware logo** which is located on the left end of the toolbar to display the main menu. Select **Preferences** option from the drop down list.
 2. Uncheck the box next to **Enable Popup Blocker** and then click **OK**.

Viewpoint Toolbar

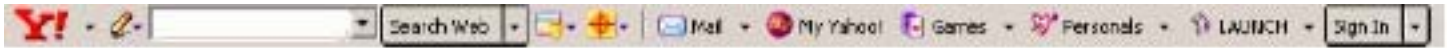
1. Click on the word **Viewpoint** on the right end of the toolbar to open the drop-down list and click on **Options Menu**.



2. In the window that opens, choose the **Pop-ups** Tab and uncheck the **Enable Pop-up Blocker** box and then click **OK**.



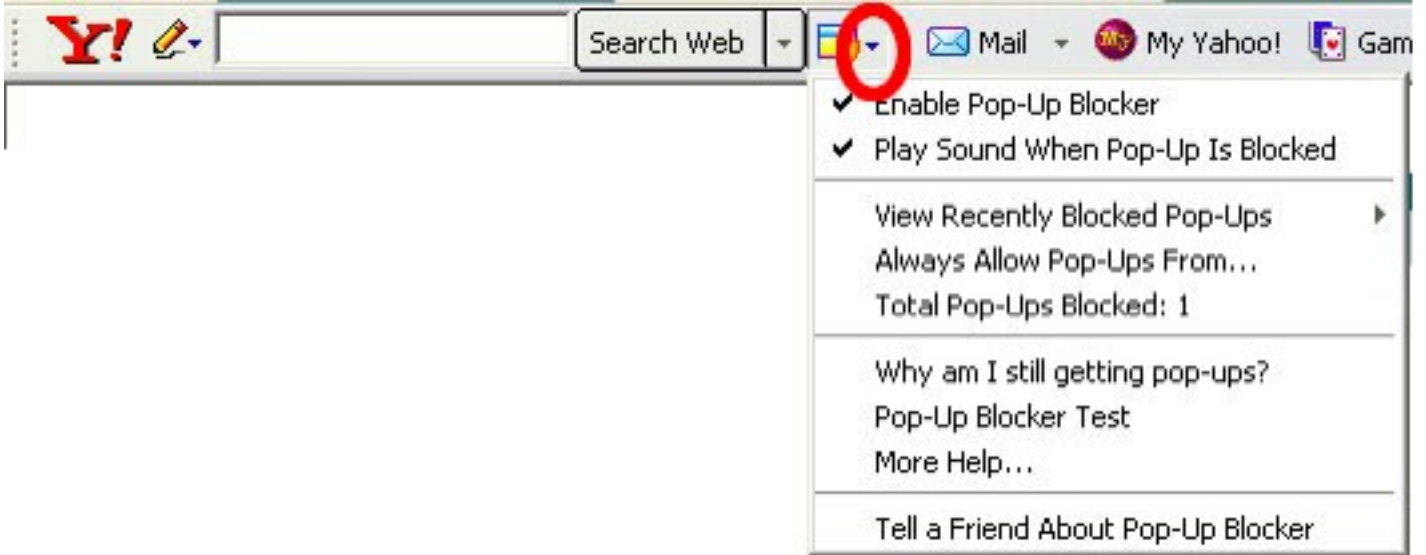
Yahoo Toolbar



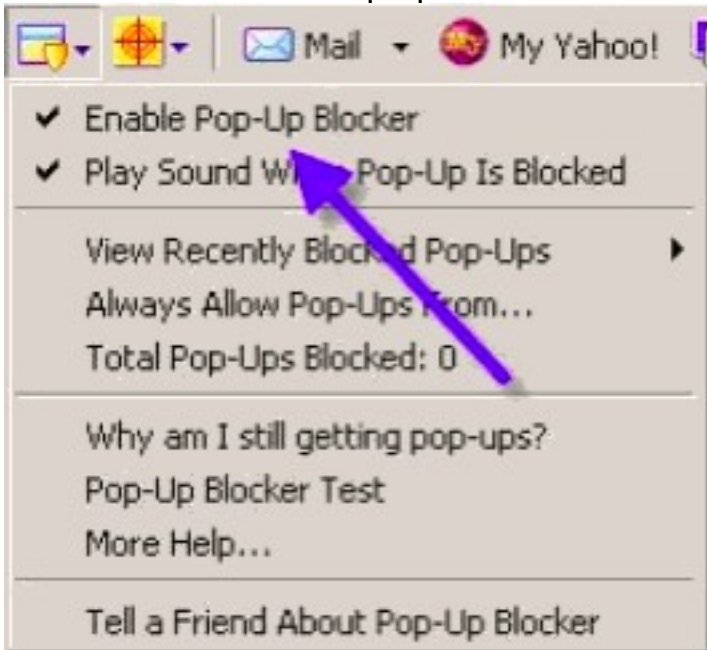
This is the Pop-up Blocker icon:

Zone Alarm
